Activity –

- **My Art Piece (my table mat)** – Create an art piece on A3 sheet by crayons or any other waste/craft material. Let the child use his/her own creativity. Child can draw anything (garden scenes, different face expression, flowers, stars, any cartoon or picture or anything of their choice). Colour and decorate nicely. Get it laminated.
